

CAREER OPPORTUNITY: ENT SURGEON

Grand River Hospital and St. Mary's General Hospital are jointly recruiting for one full time **Otolaryngologist-Head & Neck Surgeon** to fill an upcoming vacancy in the Kitchener-Waterloo area.

Grand River Hospital and St. Mary's General Hospital are two separately governed hospitals that function as an integrated system with well-defined and complementary clinical programs to serve both the local community and the region. Each hospital has acute care ED services with patient volumes reaching approximately 70,000 visits/annum. St. Mary's General Hospital is a Regional Cardiac Care Centre and a Centre of Excellence for Respiratory and Thoracic Care. Grand River Hospital hosts several regional programs including the Grand River Regional Cancer Centre, Hepatobiliary Surgery, and stroke, renal, pediatric and mental health programs. We offer round-the-clock services in orthopedics, urology, gynecology, cancer care, plastic, and reconstructive and emergency surgery as well as a wide variety of general surgeries. Our surgeons perform approximately 10,000 procedures each year.

The hospitals are seeking an Otolaryngologist - Head & Neck surgeon who will work with the other six local ENT's, to provide specialized medical and surgical care for patients presenting with a wide range of disorders of the head and neck. In addition, the ENT Program provides regional on-call coverage, which includes Kitchener-Waterloo and Cambridge and is comprised of 8 regional otolaryngologists in total.

The candidate must be eligible for independent practice licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario, and hold certification by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada in Otolaryngology - Head & Neck Surgery.
