The Department of Surgery, Division of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery, at Scarborough Health Network (SHN) is seeking an otolaryngologist with advanced fellowship training in sleep medicine to join our team. The successful candidate will play a central role in the development and enhancement of the current sleep medicine otolaryngology residency program based at SHN within the Department of Otolaryngology Head and Neck Surgery at the University of Toronto. The role will support the expansion of the current sleep medicine residency program into a multidisciplinary sleep medicine fellowship program.

The successful candidate will be working with a strong, supportive, and collegial group of otolaryngology colleagues in a three-site large community hospital organization. At SHN, we are committed to providing high quality, comprehensive clinical otolaryngologic surgical services to our local community for both the adult and pediatric population. Dedicated elective OR and ambulatory out-patient clinic time will be provided. Participation in equitable on-call coverage for all SHN sites as scheduled by the division lead will be required.

The successful candidate must be registered or eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario and have successfully completed a fellowship in Otolaryngology with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. Emphasis will be placed on candidates with a strong interest in working in a large community teaching hospital setting.

The successful candidate will be expected to obtain a faculty appointment at the University of Toronto to contribute to SHN's academic mission. A post graduate Masters degree or above would be considered an asset. Opportunities to engage in research will be available through the SHN Research Institute.
